Retaining rustic authenticity yet offering all the latest technology, every room at Atzaró is different: from fountains, Jacuzzis and private terraces to fireplaces, balconies, four poster beds and sitting rooms, each space offers a unique luxury experience. Set amongst vibrant bougainvillea, jasmine and geraniums you can enjoy the very best from the well-being Spa. With 8 treatment areas offering a range of therapies, a dry sauna, Hammam, yoga temples and a choice of pools you need never leave the hotel. A 43 metre pool allows lap training and Aqua sports, or simply enjoy the beautiful serene views from a Balinese day bed whilst enjoying a healthy freshly made organic juice or tea from the Bubbles Bar. A complete and modern gym equipped with cardiovascular, weightlifting, and aerobic and fitness items is available. The Gourmet Restaurant La Veranda offers guests Al fresco dining surrounded by fountains, ponds and flowers. In its Mediterranean menu many of the delightful ingredients come from Atzaró's own organic vegetable and herb gardens. If you can tear yourself away from this haven of tranquility for a day at the Cala Nova beach, the Atzaró has two restaurants: The Atzaró Beach Restaurant (rices, paella and fresh fish) and the Chiringuito with a more light cuisine and cocktails.
