### LUXURY, COMFORT AND CHARM

**C**a la Maria is a Boutique Bed and Breakfast situated in the fashionable Eixample district of Barcelona, just off Passeig de Gracia - one of Barcelona's grandest streets for architecture, the most staggering of which are both by Gaudí: Casa Milà (La Pedrera) and Casa Batlló. Its location makes it an ideal base for those looking for the hustle and bustle of the city but who at the same time want to enjoy tranquility and comfort. Guests have access to a private wooden terraced area planted with cacti, fruit trees and succulents, that spans several adjacent rooftops. Take breakfast in the Mediterranean sun or enjoy an outdoor drink from Ca La Maria's honesty bar. The hotel occupies the once much-prized piso principal (first floor) of a 1920s building, whose sculpted façade and elegant balconies are typical of a period that's still remembered as a cultural high-point of Catalonia. At the time, Catalan-Modernist architecture pioneered by the likes of Antoni Gaudí was most fashionable. The piso principal was typically the most elaborate and spacious of all the floors, and this one now houses five guest rooms. The rooms vary in style, showcasing very unique elements and works of art inspired and related to Barcelona after which the rooms are named. A stained glass doorway to the huge Monjuïc Apartment Suite opens to Daniel Canogar's artwork "Horror Vacui" and photographs captured in the district's cultural institutions, including Spencer Tunick's "Barcelona". Featuring 2 bedrooms, a living room with furnished details such as Le Corbusier's "Petit" armchair, high ceilings with ornate coving and private outdoor balcony, comfort and charm are guaranteed. All rooms and suites feature: air-conditioning and heating; Wi-Fi internet connection; flat-screen TV. In the elegant living room that overlooks the breakfast area and terrace, you will also find a bespoke collection of art.
